Ordinance #974 – An Ordinance to Submit to a Vote of the Registered Electors of the City of Rocky Ford, Colorado at a Municipal Election on November 7, 2023, a Question of Whether to Increase the City Sales Tax by One Percent (1%) Per Year for Three Years by Increasing the City Sales Tax Rate from Three Percent (3%) to Four Percent (4%), Which is One Quarter of the Annual Sales Tax Collected, to be Effective January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2027, and Restricting the Use of Revenues from the Additional One Percent Sales Tax as Follows: The Increase Shall be Used to Continue to Repair Streets, Sidewalks and Other Physical Improvements in the City According to a Council Approved Repair Schedule, on second reading
