



CITY OF ROCKY FORD – CITY COUNCIL **SPECIAL MEETING**

January 29, 2021

SPECIAL MEETING: 6:00 p.m. - The purpose of the special meeting is to consider, discuss and possibly change the payment option for the vac truck and two (2) executive sessions.

Rocky Ford City Council met in special session at 2:30 p.m. on Friday, January 29, 2021 at 408 N. Main Street. Mayor Susan Jung called the meeting to order. Those present at roll call were:

Finance Director Azucenda Estrada suggested to Council that they reconsider the payment option for the vac truck that was previously authorized. She suggested that Council authorize the purchase "outright" instead of the financing. The City auditors are also in favor of this option as it saves the City over \$19,000. Councilmember Rose moved to authorize and allow the outright purchase instead of financing. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Grasmick. Voting results were:

YES Geist, Rose, Ruiz, Cordova, Grasmick, Corbin-Romero, Jung




ADJOURNMENT
